# The MedPrep Program

MedPrep is a free summer enrichment program for underrepresented and/or economically disadvantaged college students interested in the medical field. Students develop key skills and competencies that are important on the road to medical school.

## Program Highlights

- ☆ Attend New Jersey Medical School or Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons (based on residency)
- ☆ Supplemental Enrichment from Mount Sinai School of Medicine
- ☆ Stipend Support
- ☆ No Application Fee
- ☆ MCAT Prep
- ☆ Clinical and Research Experience
- ☆ Academic Counseling and Mentoring



## How does the program work?

- ★ Enter a summer program for *3 summers* beginning June 2010
  - ☆ MedPrep 1 (7 weeks): Attend science classes, seminars, study sessions and MCAT prep introduction
  - ☆ MedPrep 2 (6weeks): Clinical experience, MCAT prep intensive
  - ☆ MedPrep 3 (6 weeks): Clinical experience, medical research and data collection
- ★ Clinical Experience
  - ☆ Receive hands-on training from a medical professional
- ★ MCAT Prep and Medical School Application Guidance
  - ☆ Learn test-taking techniques
  - ☆ Participate in mock admission interviews
- ★ Research and Data Collection
  - ☆ Learn various research and data collection methodologies

## What are the requirements?

- ☆ **Current** College Freshman or Sophomore in good academic standing
- ☆ Resident of New York City's five boroughs, Long Island, Westchester, or New Jersey
- ☆ 3 summer commitment
